New Committee Election

Elections undertaken by secret ballot, explained conditions for election are achieving over 1/2 of the total votes, only band members are eligible to vote.

President: Candidates; 2

Votes; Dominic Burrell – 28, RON – 1

Dominic Burrell elected to Band President by majority.

Treasurer: Candidates; 2

Votes; Matthew Durey – 28, RON – 1

Matthew Durey elected to Band Treasurer by majority.

Secretary: Candidates; 2

Votes; Katherine Jones – 29, RON – 0

Katherine Jones is elected to Band Secretary by majority.

Librarian: Candidates; 2

Votes; Michael Howe – 29, RON – 0

Michael Howe is re-elected as Band Librarian by majority.

Concert Secretary: Candidates; 2

Votes; Alasdair Hill and Lucy Lyndon-Jones joint – 29, RON – 0

Alasdair Hill and Lucy Lyndon-Jones are jointly elected as Band concert secretary by majority

Social Secretary: Candidates; 2

Votes; Joshua Moorhouse – 29, RON – 0

Joshua Moorhouse is elected as Band social secretary by majority.

President's Report:

- Band has experienced a successful year with 2 good concerts so far and coming 6th in the first university brass band championships (beating Cambridge).
- Year Started with the band's first ever tour which went to Bournemouth where we played in bandstands and at Poole's 10th Party in the Park
- Played 2 carol concerts in the Sheldonian Theatre before Christmas
- Successfully applied for and received funding from both OUMS and the proctors towards travel costs for Lancaster
- Become a full voting member within OUMS
- Been asked to play at the Encaenia garden party for the proctors
- After the most competitive auditions since the founding of the band a professional conductor has agreed to conduct the band next year

Treasurer's Report:

- Band has made over £500 profit over the course of this year, this is even before our concert this term which we have managed to secure a free venue for
- Profit made from concerts and busking
- This profit is despite the band purchases including as new music and a bass drum
- Band currently has just under £2000 (plus proceeds from upcoming concert) in which to enter the new academic year
